PROSTATE CANCER FACTS

- Prostate cancer is the most commonly diagnosed cancer in American men and the second leading cause of cancer death in men.
- One in 9 men will be diagnosed with prostate cancer during his lifetime.
- Nationally, 164,690 new cases (19% of new cancer cases) & 29,430 deaths in US
- All men are at risk of developing prostate cancer, some more than others. Risk factors include:
 - African American ancestry
 - Family history, paternal bloodline
 - Aging
- African American men are disproportionately impacted by this disease
 - 1 in 6 African American men will be diagnosed
 - African American men are more than 2 times likely to die of the disease than white men
- Men should know their personal risk for the disease and talk with their health professional to make an informed plan for testing
- The NCCN recommends men begin testing at age 45 with a PSA (prostate specific antigen) test
- There is hope! There are many treatment options for men diagnosed with prostate cancer – at any stage. Upon a diagnosis ask questions, get the facts about your disease, seek a second opinion and make the best decision for you.
